

Using Notans to Strengthen Composition with Alice S. Helwig

Supply List

- ☐ Acrylic Paints. Bring at least the primaries. Recommended colours:
 - Hansa Yellow,
 - Quinadrocrome Crimson
 - Pthalo Blue
 - Titanium White
 - You can bring some of your other favourite colours if you wish.
- ☐ An acrylic Black, it can be one of the following: Payne's Grey, Ivory Black, or Mars Black
- ☐ Acrylic Fluid Medium (it can be any sheen – matte, gloss or satin)
- ☐ A physical print out of 2 different reference landscape photos. 8 x 10. (Hint: if you have a library card you can print out coloured photocopies there.) We will be using one reference for the morning and the other for the afternoon.
- ☐ Canvas, or canvas board, or wood panel – one 9x12
- ☐ We will also be doing studies so you will need 4 5x7 surfaces – can be canvas, canvas board, thicker water colour paper (140 lbs at least), wood panels... (Alice likes to use canvas taped to an election board)
- ☐ Masking tape
- ☐ Brushes - an assortment of soft and stiffer bristles. You should have one that is at least 1 ½ inch thick
- ☐ Water containers
- ☐ Rags
- ☐ Palette – make sure it is a reasonable size. An 8x10 or bigger strippable palette will work
- ☐ Palette knife
- ☐ Black sharpie pen, thicker
- ☐ Table cloth
